



Taking care of your Water Supply in Cookston Road, Portlethen - Update & Road Closure Info.

As you may be aware we are currently carrying out work to renew the water main in Cookston Road area of Portlethen to continue to provide our customers with clear, fresh drinking water and to reduce the chances of pipes bursting.

Update: Works are currently progressing with Sections 1 & 2, and we will soon be starting sections 3 & 4 of the work. These sections involve traffic management to be in place which includes the closure of Cookston Road.

Section 3: Traffic Lights - Starts from 20th June 2022

Section 4: Road Closures - Starts from 11th July 2022

Section 3 Works: From 20th June (approx. 3 weeks): During this section of works the following will be in place.

- 4-way temporary traffic lights at junction of Cookston Road, Barclayhill Place and McIntosh Donald entrance.
- The Traffic Lights will be in place to allow safe installation of new water main across the junction with Barclayhill Place

Section 4 Works: From 11th July (approx. 3-4 weeks): During this section of works the following will be in place.

- **Full Road Closure** of Cookston Road between Barclayhill Place and Thistle Drive
- Local diversions will be in place. Access to Barclayhill Place & McIntosh Donald from the North, access to Thistle Drive from the South. Please follow all signs put in place.

Sections 5 & 6 works: Will follow on from Section 4. See below for details:

- **Section 5 (approx. 5 weeks following section 4):** involves a **full road closure** in Cookston Road from Thistle Drive to Roundabout at Muirend Road. Access to Barclayhill Place, McIntosh Donald & Thistle Drive from the North. Towards the end of this section there will be temporary traffic lights in place at the roundabout at Muirend Road, Cookston Road & Devenick Drive.
- **Section 6 (follows completion of Section 5 for approx. 8 weeks)** – involves **full road closure** of Muirend Road from the roundabout at Cookston Road to the roundabout at the Retail Park.

Note: Dates and durations for each section may be subject to change depending on progress of the works

During these sections of Works there will be some disruption to local bus services. Please see below for details:

Bus Services: Bus services will be affected during Sections 4, 5 and 6 of the works. Details of this can be found below:

During Section 4 & 5 (Cookston Road Closure):

Service 7/ 7A/7B/7S/8 - Southbound buses will operate as normal via the A92, then will be diverted to enter Portlethen at Muirend Road, then via Cookston Road and Bruntland Road then as per normal route within Portlethen to Muirend Road, serving the bus stop opposite Asda, then via A92 and as per normal route.

Northbound buses will operate as normal within Portlethen but will exit via A92 at Muirend Road.

The area of Schoolhill and Hillside will not be served by bus services over this closure and passengers are advised to use the nearest alternative bus stop on Muirend Road (Asda).

During Section 6 (Muirend Road Closure):

Services 7/7A/7B/7S/8 – Southbound services will operate as normal into Portlethen via Schoolhill, then after serving Portlethen Academy, use Muirend Road to serve Asda. Buses will then double back the same way to get to Berrymuir Road, then as per normal route.

Northbound buses will operate via the same route but serve Muirend Road (Asda) before serving Berrymuir Road, then exit via Schoolhill and Hillside to the A92.

Signage: Please note advanced signage will be in place ahead of each road closure.

Local Access: Local access will be maintained where possible. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Our site team will liaise with any customer if access is likely to be restricted in anyway. Please follow all signage in place.

Interruption to Water Supply: During this phase of work we may need to interrupt your water supply. If you are to be affected by any planned interruption to supply you will receive notification in advance, detailing date, times and what to do.
