Appendix B: Out of School Care Policy Context

- October 2022: <u>Best Start: Strategic early learning and school age childcare plan:</u> focuses on building a national system of school age childcare and a new early learning and childcare (ELC) offer for one and two-year-olds.
- April 2023: Additional £15 million funding to support families: through 12 pilot projects across the areas of Dundee, Clackmannanshire, Glasgow, and Inverclyde
- October 2023 <u>'School age childcare delivery framework'</u>: sets out Scottish
 Government's commitment, action areas and the approach over the next two to three
 years to deliver a system of affordable and accessible school age childcare which will
 be funded for those families who need it most.
- December 2023: <u>'National Improvement Framework and improvement plan 2024'</u>: sets out the vision and priorities for Scottish education, including actions including:
- SI 99: design of wrap around childcare system providing care before and after school, all year.
- o SI 100: plans to support priority groups with school aged childcare
- SI 101: supporting low income households with coordinated access to food, childcare and activities during the holidays.
