The railway touches most communities in Scotland, which means we have neighbours who live close to the tracks and other infrastructure.

It's our role to run a safe, reliable, and efficient railway, serving customers and communities and we wanted to let you know that we're carrying out: **Re-Sleepering at Portlethen**

We'll work during the day when we can, however for this job we're working close to the railway line which means we must work at night. This keeps our staff safe and minimises disruption to passenger and freight services. We'll be using specialised equipment, vehicles and plant machinery which will generate some noise. We're sorry for any disturbance this may cause.

The works are planned to be undertaken as follows:

Main works: Re-Sleepering & Ballast Tamping

Plant & Staff Access will be via: Portlethen Yard, off Cookston Rd, Portlethen, AB12 4JS

There will be an increase of traffic in the area as heavy plant machinery arrives in the vicinity and is used on track for the jobs required (eg: Road-Rail Vehicles, Tamping Machines), together with multiple staff arriving on-site to operate both heavy and small plant electronic machinery (eg: Hand & Power tools), therefore this will be noisy at times.
