The railway touches most communities in Scotland, which means we have neighbours who live close to the tracks and other infrastructure.

It's our role to run a safe, reliable, and efficient railway, serving customers and communities and we wanted to let you know that we're carrying out:

Our Rail drop delivery train service between Portlethen & Hill of Findon

We'll work during the day when we can, however for this job we're working close to the railway line which means we must work at night. This keeps our staff safe and minimises disruption to passenger and freight services. We'll be using specialised equipment, vehicles and plant machinery which will generate some noise. We're sorry for any disturbance this may cause.

The works are planned to be undertaken as follows:

Main works: Rail Drop Train off-loading rails at specified points between the mileages above.
Staff Access will be via: Portlethen Station Yard, off Cookston Rd, Portlethen, AB12 4JS

There will be a slight increase of traffic in the area as our staff & vehicles arrive in the vicinity and begin working within the permitted line possession times on the trackside and as the delivery train off-loads at the points required, this will be noisy at times.
